Jennifer Martin currently oversees global investigations for Symantec where she supervises a wide variety of internal investigations, including advising on cyber security and data breach matters. From 1999–2004, Ms. Martin served as Senior Counsel in the US Department of Justice’s Computer Crime and Intellectual Property Section, where she focused on the international aspects of cyber crime, including negotiating the Council of Europe Convention on Cyber Crime and working with members of the European Union on policy issues; provided investigative and legal support on numerous domestic and international cyber crime cases; and prosecuted a high-profile Economic Espionage Act case. Corporations and organizations are increasingly called upon to respond to malicious acts, including thefts of data, fraud, extortion, and computer intrusions, committed against and through computers. When confronted with such an event, lawyers and IT personnel must work together to determine what kind of damage has been done, how best to preserve critical evidence, and whether and how to report such incidents. The presentation will focus on the types of digital evidence that might exist to assess your situation and support your investigation, and how to preserve such evidence in a forensically sound manner. We will briefly go over when notification of such incidents is required under the law, and the pros and cons of reporting such events to law enforcement. This presentation will help prepare inside and outside counsel and their paralegals to effectively respond to online fraud and abuse, including thefts of sensitive personal identifying information, when such an event occurs.

She began her legal career as an associate at Sidley Austin in Washington DC, after clerking for Judge Rosemary Barkett on the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals, and for Chief Judge Theodore McKee on the 3rd Circuit Court of Appeals. In addition to her legal degree, Ms. Martin possesses a Masters Degree in Mathematics.
